

Bar Exam Prohibited Item List

The following items are strictly prohibited. Examinees are NOT permitted to bring the following into the testing facility:

NO electronic devices, including but not limited to: smart watches, digital watches or timers, smart glasses, fitness trackers, or other wearable technology; cameras or any picture-taking devices; audio or media players, tablets, language translators; earbuds or headphones (including noise-cancelling devices); external monitors; wireless mice and keyboards; or e-cigarettes. Cell phones are permitted in accordance with the protocol set forth in the Information and Instruction Memorandum and Admission Ticket.

NO firearms or other weapons of any kind.

NO notes, papers, books, bar review or other study materials in any format.

NO scratch paper or paper of any kind. *Scratch paper will be provided.*

NO pencils, erasers, pens, highlighters, or rulers. *Pencils, pens, and highlighters will be provided.*

NO laptop cases or sleeves, briefcases, handbags, or backpacks of any kind.

NO ear plugs or headphones. *Ear plugs will be provided.*

NO Bluetooth devices including ear buds, air tags, wireless external keyboards, or wireless mice.

NO head coverings of any kind other than for religious reasons. Hooded shirts may be worn in the testing room, but the hoods must stay down during testing.

NO mouse pads, or laptop accessories. Only laptop power cords and power adapters ARE allowed for registered laptop users on Tuesday, MEE and MPT testing day.

NO flash drives.

NO flip-flops or other shoes or clothing which are noisy and can disrupt other candidates.

NO large jewelry or hair accessories.

NO cigarettes, tobacco-related products, matches or lighters.

NO tissue. *Tissue will be provided.*

NO food, candy, gum, or beverages other than water unless prior approval granted (Non-ADA Accommodation Request Form).

Examinees found in possession of prohibited items may be dismissed from the test, and their scores may be cancelled, as determined by the testing jurisdiction.
